You'll be provided the opportunity to set up an account from which one-time or recurrent gifts can be made. The recurrent option is a great tool to pay regular tithes and offerings-you specify the amount and frequency and donations are made automatically! All donations are confirmed by email and your online account provides a summary of donations for your review and/or tax purposes.
